Employed at the Royal Mint, Mal Johnson of Lloyd Street, Gelli, was a stalwart member of the Second Bass section for forty years. He actually joined the First Bass section in 1956 before transferring to another section some years later. He was a faithful chorister who displayed incredible passion for the Choir and refused to hear any criticism of it. It was during the Choir's tour of America in 1994 that he learned of the death of his wife Jean and sadly less than two years later Mal also passed away, aged 60.
